Staff recommends:

1. Amend Section 12.218, Administrative Code, Membership to reflect the underlined revisions:
 - a. The Broward County Bicycling and Pedestrian Advisory Committee shall consist of eleven ~~ten (11) (10)~~ members. Each member of the Board of County Commissioners shall appoint one (1) member to the Committee. And Two (2) members shall be appointed by the Broward League of Cities, or its successor organization. The two (2) members appointed by the Broward League of Cities shall be individuals who have demonstrated interest in architecture, engineering, land use, or planning.
