	Narrative clearly explaining the proposed changes. ☐ Include the most current note for the plat and the proposed note for the plat. ☐ Include a list of existing uses within the plat with the gross square footage of each use. ☐ Include the history of the plat and subsequent plat note amendments, if applicable.
	Copy of the plat and, if applicable, subsequent recorded plat note amendment agreement(s).
	Opinion of Title with a search date within thirty (30) days of formal submittal.
	For projects in an incorporated municipality, correspondence (Resolution, Ordinance, No objection Letter, etc.) from the municipality approving the proposed plat note language. The correspondence must include the existing and proposed plat note language consistent with the note submitted to the County. ☐ If the property is located within a Development of Regional Impact (DRI), the correspondence shall also indicate if the proposed note is consistent with the approved DRI Development Order.
	Other relevant documentation, as deemed necessary.

	For residential development, an active School Capacity Availability Determination (SCAD) Letter.
	For development projects on or adjacent to a state road, a valid pre-application approval letter from the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT).
	If a new parcel or tract is being created on the plat, a signed and sealed sketch and legal description for the new parcel or tract.
