Ares: 24.2 acres

Location: South side of Wiles Road, between North Powerline Road and the Florida Turnpike (see map below)

The proposed amendment will be reviewed by the Local Planning Agency (LPA) at a public hearing tentatively scheduled for 1:00 pm on Friday, April 17, 2020 at the Broward County Governmental Center West, Hearing Room (2nd Floor), 1 North University Drive, FL 33324. This meeting will also be noticed on the Broward County website and in the Sun-Sentinel newspaper at least ten (10) days prior.

This is the first step in the amendment process. There will also be future public hearings to consider the amendment before Broward County Planning Council and the Board of County Commissioners prior to the Board considering final action.
