## PH 1 RECERTIFICATION PCR 25-9

**Public Hearing on Recertification of the City of Tamarac Future Land Use Element – Map Amendment** – Recertified the City's Future Land Use Element per Planning Council staff recommendation.

## PH 3 AMENDMENT PC 25-1

**Public Hearing on Amendment to the Broward County Land Use Plan – Town of Southwest Ranches** – Recommended approval per Planning Council staff recommendation, recognizing the applicant's voluntary commitment to restrict development to a maximum of 716,000 square feet of commercial and industrial uses, of which a maximum of 116,000 square feet of development is designated for commercial uses, including not requiring a second Planning Council public hearing. Further, if the County Commission approves the amendment, this action by the Planning Council shall serve as the "conditional" recertification of the municipal plan.

Public Hearing on Amendment to the Environmentally Sensitive Lands (ESL) Map of the Broward County Land Use Plan Natural Resource Map Series – Site 66 / Map Label 83 - City of Fort Lauderdale – Recommended approval to remove Site 66/Map Label 83 from the Environmentally Sensitive Lands Map, recognizing the restoration and preservation of the existing 1.68-acre natural area to the west of the site as a conservation easement, as well as the offsite mitigation, including not requiring a second Planning Council public hearing.
