The Director of Purchasing Memorandum, dated October 17, 2025, informed the Evaluation Committee that AT&T Enterprises, LLC dba AT&T Enterprises Florida, LLC's (AT&T) location certification as a Locally Based Subsidiary was subject to review by the Director of Purchasing in accordance with [Section 1-74 Broward County Local Preference Ordinance](#).

The Director of Purchasing has performed a comprehensive review of all supporting documents submitted by AT&T and has determined that AT&T does not meet the eligibility criteria for a Local business, a Locally based business, or a Locally based subsidiary.

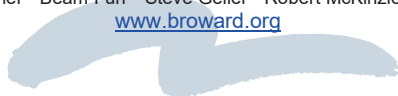
As a result, AT&T's location certification in Section C. Additional Information, Item 6, of the Director of Purchasing Memorandum has been revised from Locally Based Subsidiary to Not Local and the allocated points will remain at zero. Additionally, Section E. Tiebreaker, Item 1, has also been updated to reflect AT&T as not eligible for tiebreaker.

Dear Mr. Lindborg and Mr. Ruiz:

The Director of Purchasing Memorandum, dated October 17, 2025, informed the Evaluation Committee that AT&T Enterprises, LLC dba AT&T Enterprises Florida, LLC's (AT&T) location certification as a Locally Based Subsidiary was subject to review by the Director of Purchasing in accordance with [Section 1-74 Broward County Local Preference Ordinance](#).

Background:

To be considered either a Local Business, a Locally Based Business, or a Locally Based Subsidiary, a vendor must comply with the requirements as stated in [Sec. 1-74. – Definitions](#).

AT&T attested to Option 3, Local Business and Locally Based Subsidiary, on the Location Certification Form submitted with its proposal. Upon reviewing the form and other documentation provided, the Purchasing Division determined that additional information was necessary regarding your firm's attestation (Exhibit 1).

On October 8, 2025, a "Local Business Questionnaire" was issued to AT&T seeking additional documentation ("evidence") on your firm's eligibility as a Locally Based Subsidiary (Exhibit 2).

Determination:

Following a comprehensive review of all supporting documentation submitted by AT&T, the Director of Purchasing has determined that AT&T does not meet the eligibility criteria for a Local business, a Locally based business, or a Locally based subsidiary, based on the following:

1) Broward County Local Business Tax Receipt

The Broward County local business tax receipt submitted with AT&T's proposal was issued to Bellsouth Telecommunications, LLC, rather than to AT&T, the proposing entity for this solicitation (Exhibit 3).

In response to the Local Business Questionnaire, AT&T indicated that the correct local business address is 8600 W. Oakland Park Boulevard, Sunrise, FL 33351. A search conducted on the Broward County Tax Collector Office's website confirmed that AT&T does not currently hold a Broward County Business Tax Receipt for the Sunrise, FL address.

Additionally, based on the Organizational Chart provided in response to the Local Business Questionnaire, it appears that AT&T and Bellsouth Telecommunications, LLC dba AT&T Florida are distinct legal entities, both wholly owned subsidiaries of AT&T, Inc, and neither entity is a subsidiary of the other (Exhibit 4).

2) Office Responsible for Project

The "Vendor Questionnaire and Standard Certifications" submitted with AT&T's proposal indicated the "Office location responsible for this project" (question no. 7) was 600 NW 79th Avenue, Miami, FL 33126-4018. Accordingly, the Sunrise, FL location is not identified as the location from which a "substantial component" of the services proposed for this solicitation will be performed (Exhibit 5).

Additionally, based on the information provided in your firm's Local Business Questionnaire, the entities operating from Sunrise, FL location are: Bellsouth Telecommunications, LLC, AT&T Mobility Services LLC, and AT&T Services, Inc. The proposing entity, AT&T Enterprises, LLC dba AT&T Enterprises Florida, LLC's was not indicated from operating out of the Sunrise, FL location.

3) Principal Place of Business

Under the definition of a Locally Based Subsidiary, the location must serve as the Vendor's "nerve center" and "principal place of business". According to AT&T's Vendor Questionnaire and Standard Certifications, AT&T's principal place of business (question no. 6) is listed as 208 Akard Street, Dallas, TX 75202. The Sunrise, FL location is not indicated as its principal place of business.

Additionally, AT&T's Local Business Questionnaire response (question no. 10) indicated that the Miami office "has similar job titles" operating out of the Broward location (Sunrise, FL). However, it also states the Miami address also has "Legal Dept, Finance, Government Affairs, Accounting, Customer service and Wireline Sales" from the Miami, FL office location. As such, there is no evidence to support Sunrise, FL as the principal place of business for AT&T.

Conclusion:

Based on the review of all documentation provided and in accordance with the specific criteria outlined in the Local Preference Ordinance, it has been determined that AT&T does not qualify as a Locally Based Subsidiary. Additionally, it is determined that AT&T cannot be considered "Local" or "Locally Based" (per Ordinance definitions) and is therefore ineligible for Local Preference under this solicitation.

As a result, your firm's location status will be identified as Not Local. Accordingly, the allocated Local Preference points will remain at zero, and your firm will be ineligible for the location-based tiebreaker.

AT&T is a leading American multinational corporation and a publicly traded company. It consistently holds a top position on the Fortune 500 list. Due to its status as a widely held public company, it is virtually impossible to determine the exact percentage of AT&T stock owned by investors outside of Broward County. However, AT&T maintains a significant local presence, currently owning and operating more than 27 locations within Broward County.

Regional management, Sales, Engineering, Finance, Government Affairs, Technicians, Accounting and Construction.

We have upper level management titles located in both the Miami and Sunrise offices which oversee the Technicians and Construction teams.

Yes, both locations have management teams that can make some pricing and staffing decisions independent of our corporate HQ in Dallas. Some local operational decisions are made out of both our Miami and Sunrise offices as well.

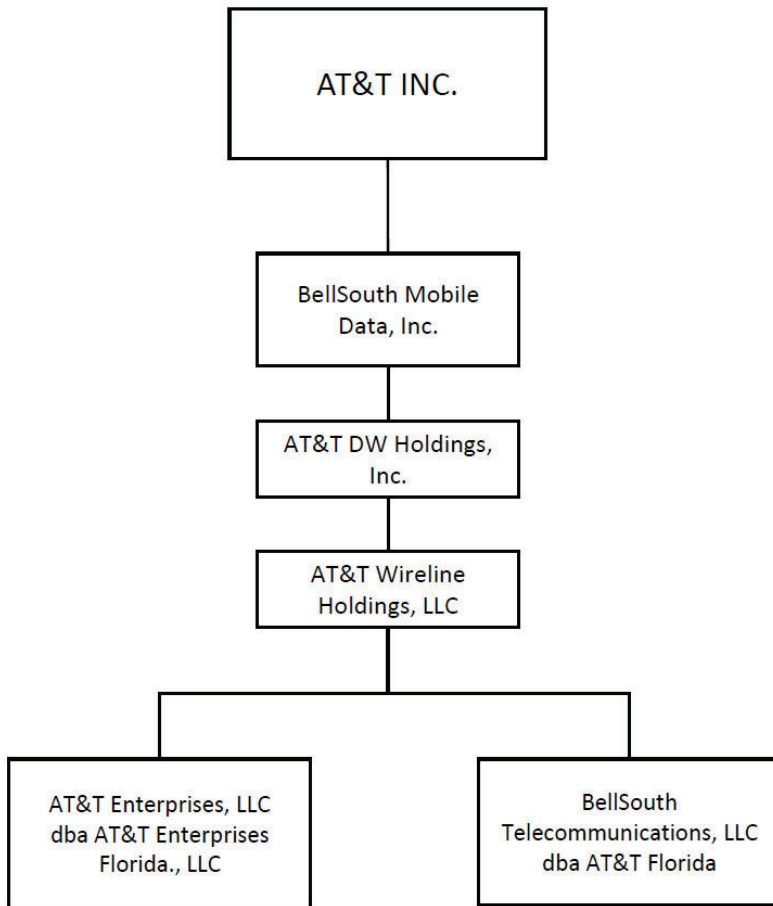
