## **DID YOU KNOW?**

- The Broward County Government Recycling Program provides recycling collection services and program support to more than 110 county parks and government facilities.
- The Program develops recycling campaigns, educational materials, and recycling related training to educate on recycling best practices.
- Coordinates public outreach events, conducts daily recycling assessments to ensure compliance and recommend service level adjustments for both recycling and waste based on field audits.
- 2,160,920 lbs. were recycled from Broward County government buildings and County parks in FY 2024.

- Plastic plates
- Food
- Food containers
- Paper plates
- Paper towels
- Pizza boxes
- Aluminum foil
- 🛑 Tissue paper
- Styrofoam
