2 ORDINANCE NO. 80-23

3 AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MARGATE, CREATING A WATER
4 CONTROL DISTRICT TO BE KNOWN AS COCOMAR WATER CONTROL
5 DISTRICT; PROVIDING FOR THE ESTABLISHING OF BOUNDARIES
6 OF THE DISTRICT; PROVIDING FOR THE BOARD OF COUNTY
7 COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA, TO BE THE
8 GOVERNING BODY; PROVIDING FOR A DISTRICT ADVISORY BOARD;
9 PROVIDING FOR THE POWERS OF THE GOVERNING BODY AND
10 ADVISORY BOARD; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING
11 FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

12 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF MARGATE,

13 FLORIDA:

14 SECTION 1: CREATION AND BOUNDARIES

15 1.01 That there is hereby created a Water Control District to
16 be known as COCOMAR WATER CONTROL DISTRICT. The District shall be comprised
17 of the area bounded as follows, said area being located within Broward County,
18 Florida; a portion of which is located within the municipal boundaries of the
19 City of Margate:

20 On the North by the south right-of-way line of the
21 Hillsboro Canal; on the East by the west right-of-way
22 line of the Florida Turnpike; on the South by the north
23 right-of-way line of the C-14 Canal; on the West by
24 the centerline of the right-of-way of Florida State
25 Road #7.

26 SECTION 2: GOVERNING BODY AND ADVISORY BOARD

27 2.01 The Governing body of the District shall be the Board of
28 County Commissioners of Broward County, Florida. In order to assist the
29 governing body, there shall be a District Advisory Board which shall consist
30 of three (3) persons, including a chairman, who shall be so designated by
31 the District Advisory Board.

32 2.02 Each member of the District Advisory Board shall reside or
33 own property within the District. The Board of County Commissioners shall
34 appoint each member of the District Advisory Board to terms of office of two
35 (2) years. However, on initial appointments, one of the three (3) appointed
36 members shall serve a term of one (1) year. The members of the District
37 Advisory Board shall receive no compensation for their services in such
38 capacities, except that they may be reimbursed for expenses incurred in the
39 performance of their duties. The Board of County Commissioners shall appoint
40 such members as are necessary to fill expired terms of the Advisory Board
41 when a vacancy occurs for any reason other than expiration of the term for
42 an appointed member of the District Advisory Board. Such vacancy shall be

filled for the remainder of the term by the Board of County Commissioners.

SECTION 3: POWERS

3.01 The Board of County Commissioners of Broward County, Florida, shall have all powers and duties as the governing body as set forth and provided for in Chapter 36 of the Broward County Code, as amended, including, but not limited to, the power to Levy ad valorem taxes within said district upon approval by a vote of the electros within said district.

3.02 The District Advisory Board shall have all powers and duties as set forth and provided for in Chapter 36 of the Broward County Code, as amended.


SECTION 4: SEVERABILITY

That if any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance is held to be invalid or unconstitutional by any Court of competent jurisdiction, then said holding shall in no way affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance.

SECTION 5: That this Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon adoption at its second reading.
