March Traffic

- Total traffic: 3,678,351, up 5.1%
- Domestic traffic: 2,829,219, up 5.1%
- International traffic: 849,132, up 5.2%
- FLL has had positive growth in total passenger traffic 59 out of the last 60 months

Department of Transportation Origin/Destination (O/D) Data for 2018

- FLL ranked 1st in lowest average domestic base fares among Large Hub airports
- Ranked 14th in domestic O/D traffic, travel starts or ends at FLL
- 84% of FLL's total passenger traffic is O/D

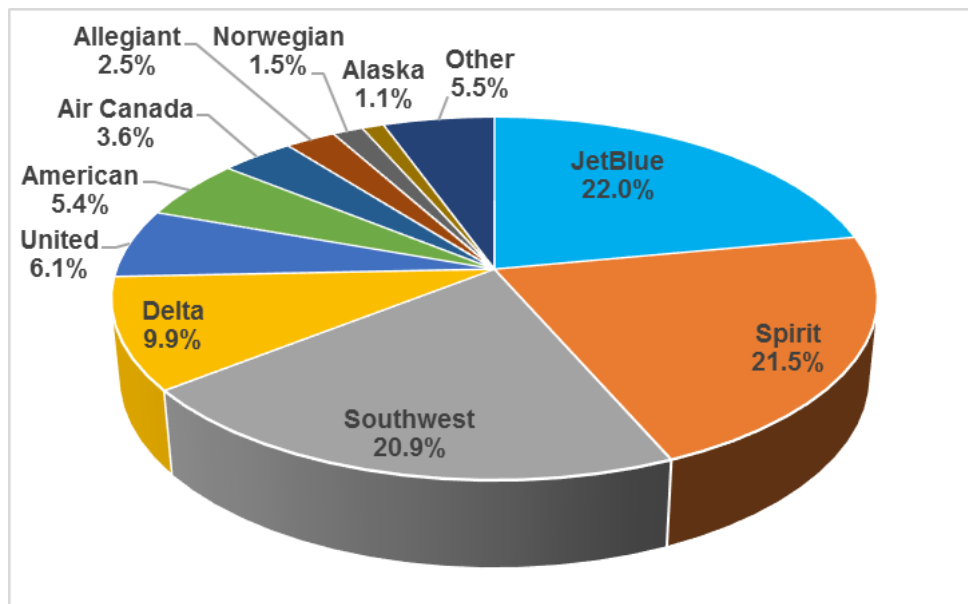
Airport Council International's Report for February
