


PROJECT SCOPE

- **➢ Widen Pine Island Road from 4 Lanes to 6 Lanes**
- > Accessibility Improvements
- Bicycle Lanes or Shared-Use Path
- ➤ Modify Signalized Intersection at Griffin Road, Orange Drive, SW 30th Street, SW 36th Street, and Nova Drive
 - Signal Warrant Study at: Forest Ridge Boulevard & Alpine Woods Road
- ➤ New Bulkhead Wall Along the Existing Canal to the East
- > New Signing & Pavement Marking
- > Potential Noise Wall
- New Lighting
- > Landscaping






TYPICAL SECTION PINE ISLAND ROAD – OPTION 1

SIGNALIZATION

- Warrant Analysis will be prepared for:
 - Forest Ridge's Entrance
 - Alpine Woods Road
- If a signal is warranted at the Forest Ridge entrance, the Town or HOA will be responsible for the design and construction costs because it is a private road.
- If a signal is warranted at Alpine Woods Road, the County will be responsible for the design and construction costs because this is a public road.
- If either signal is constructed, the County will agree to operate and maintain




NOISE WALLS

If desired:

- Residents should contact the Town of Davie to request noise walls.
- > As per County Administrative Code:
 - The request to install sound protective devices must be made by the Town of Davie to the County.
 - The Town must provide the right-of-way or easements necessary for such construction.
 - The Town must provide 50% of the construction cost.
 - The Town must maintain the noise wall.





NOISE WALLS

Pros:

Noise reduction

Cons:

- **Dedication of land**
- Removal or trees and hedges
- **Constructability concerns** with power lines and neighboring houses
- **Aesthetic change**






NOISE WALL POTENTIAL LOCATIONS




LANDSCAPING


A tree mitigation plan will be prepared:

- May relocate trees
- May plant new trees
