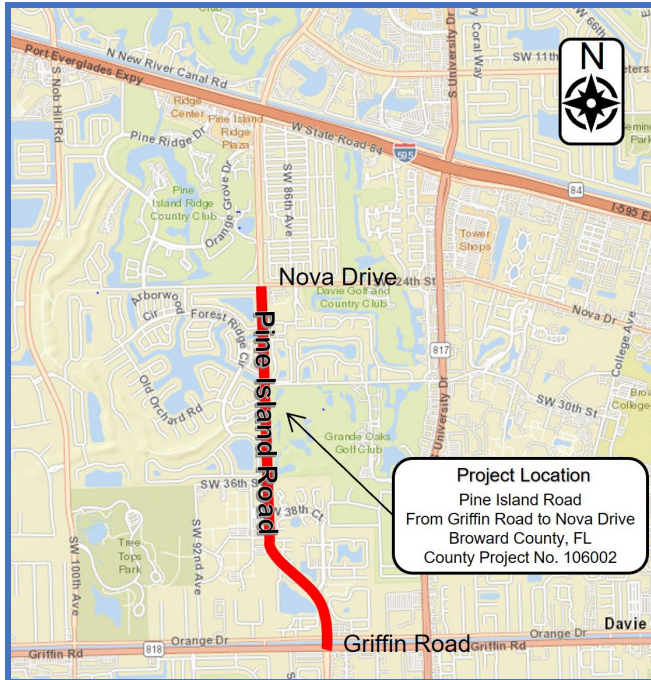


PUBLIC INFORMATION MEETING NOTICE

This project is brought to you by the Penny for Transportation Mobility Advancement Program, known as MAP Broward. The Broward County Highway Construction and Engineering Division will conduct a **PUBLIC INFORMATION MEETING** for the proposed improvements to Pine Island Road from Griffin Road to Nova Drive, in the Town of Davie.

The proposed project improvements include reconstructing the existing roadway from four to six lanes, with a shared use path or bike lanes in each direction. Additional improvements include bridge widening, signalization, signing and pavement markings, lighting, bulkhead wall along the canal, and landscaping.

This **PUBLIC INFORMATION MEETING** is being held to present the project status and provide opportunities for public input. County representatives will be available to present the project and answer questions. The public is encouraged to attend this meeting to review the proposed transportation improvements.
