A. 2015 Housing & Urban Development (HUD) Notice of Funding Availability (NOFA)

Mr. Michael Wright provided copies of the 2015 Vulnerability Index and Service Prioritization Decision Assistance Tool (VI-SPDAT) Survey Results. He informed Council members that the Point-In-Time (PIT) Count will be conducted at the end of January 2016. Mr. Wright announced that the CoC Board identified the Functional Zero figure as \$11.8 million and stated that the Board of County Commissioners is recommending the money be split proportionately among the thirty-one municipalities based on their population as compared to the overall County's population.

The Chair requested that Council members share the Housing Council's Annual Report with their respective networks. He opened the floor for discussion and feedback about composing the 2016 Work Program. Mr. Sniezek indicated that staff will identify some preliminary suggestions for the 2016 draft work program as part of the October meeting package.
