# UPDATES TO THE FLORIDA BUILDING CODE: CERTIFICATION STANDARDS

PLANTATION, Fla. – As the construction industry nationwide excels, the need for qualified personnel is greater than ever. Unfortunately, this need extends beyond the licensed code profession. Recently, the Broward County Board of Rules and Appeals tasked its Building Certification Committee to reevaluate Broward County Chapter I – Section 104 to see if there are alternative paths that could be considered for the certification of qualified individuals.

The certification committee met on numerous occasions in the past fifteen plus months to review and discuss the certification requirements and has recently finalized their findings. These new certification requirements will be reviewed and voted on at the next Board meeting scheduled for Thursday, March 14, 2019 and will be open to the public.



The meeting will be held at the Broward County Governmental Center (115 S. Andrews Avenue, Fort Lauderdale, FL 33301 - Room 422) and will begin at 7:00p.
