# A. Post Graduate CBE Program

Mr. McDonald said he compiled the suggestions received from Advisory Board members, staff, and others for implementing a mid-level CBE program for graduates from Broward County's small business program. Some considerations could include providing points to mid-level firms that submit RFQ/RFPs or that prime vendors are allowed to subcontract with a mid-level CBE firm for a defined percentage of the CBE goal. He will work with the County Attorney to draft the recommendations and present them during the October 27<sup>th</sup> Advisory Board meeting.

## **B.** Disparity Study Recommendation

On June 1<sup>st</sup>, 2021, the Broward County Board of Commissioners passed a motion directing County staff to review data currently available and provide recommendations for pursuing a disparity study. The Advisory Board will discuss the disparity study at their next meeting and make a recommendation to the Broward County Board of Commissioners.
