The transition was very successful, and the Homeless Initiative Partnership Team is working closely with Broward Partnership to ensure they are running smoothly. There is additional Grant Funding with DCF, there were agencies who applied for the Request for Proposal, applications have been reviewed, and services may start July 1, 2019 of this year. New services as in a Housing Navigator Team for all of Broward County. **Broward School District Homeless Education Liaison (HEART)** Currently to date there are a total 5020 students registered in the HEART program. 4479 - are actively enrolled in school 3059 - are living doubled up 242 - Unaccompanied youth 179 - are in High School
 - 109 are of the 179 are seniors
 - 387 Emergency and Transitional Shelter

Carole gave a brief update on the importance of the Homeless Youth and Families Shelter Provider meeting and the importance of making sure your voice is heard for who and what is needed for the committee to complete mission goals.

College Tour -

43 students were able to attend the College Tour and 1 student was accepted on the spot to Florida Gulf Coast University.

5 to 6 students who attended to College Tour were accepted to Florida Southwestern College. The goal is to take more students for next year's College Tour.

The feedback received from the volunteers and students for the College Tour were positive and everyone had a wonderful time.

Mainstreaming Education College and Career Advancement (MECCA)

This initiative will take place for ages K - 12 October 22, 2018 - June 30, 2019. There will be three locations:

- North Area Charles Drew Resource Center
- Central Area Lauderdale Manors Early Learning
- South Area Gulfstream Early Learning Center
- The Salvation Army
- Women in Distress

Offering Tutoring Services, SAT/ACT Prep, Homework Assistance, DJJ Transition, and Social Skill Development for students experiencing homelessness.

Guest Speaker:

Pam Davidson - <u>Christmas on July (18th Year)</u> A program that helps homeless children prepare for school. Every child that registers in advance are provided with:

- A pair of shoes
- Jeans
- Two shirts
- Three pairs of underwear
- Three pairs of socks
- Books
- Backpacks

- Toiletries
- School Supplies

The final date for the event is tentative, and the location will be at the BB&T Center for 2500 children.

Ana Rojas - The Salvation Army

Currently assist clients that are struggling to get out of homelessness.

The Program is called "Getting Ahead" and last for 18 weeks and meet every Thursday.

The program offers, meals, gas cards, bus passes for individuals that volunteer.

The goal is to ensure that the clients have stability.

The program is now offering a Money Smart Curriculum that provides financial education to the clients.

Send referrals one month is advance to allow time for intake processing.

In addition, with Getting Ahead, the program also offers a Staying Ahead Program that allows the client to remain stable and not get behind.

The program will also be offering a Bridges out of Poverty training that is free of charge for agencies.
