- Youth and Families-Jo-Ann Anstett reported on behalf of Carole Mitchell that over 3,700 students are currently actively registered in the HEART 'program; that HEART and Hope South Florida are exploring how Broward Schools might collaborate with in-kind support for day respite programming for homeless families; that the Homeless Youth and Families/ Shelter Providers meeting will meet on 1/10 at 1:30pm at Lauderdale Manors Elementary School; and that the Committee completed its first draft of the Turn the Curve Report, as required of all sub-committees that feed into the CSC Children's Strategic Plan, with the assistance of Dr. Keisha Grey, CSC Strategy Manager.
- Coordinated Assessment-Lorraine Wilby reported on behalf of Steve Werthman that the Committee continues reviewing the County's coordinated entry policy.
- MAT -Jo-Ann Anstett reported on behalf of Dr. Sgt. Ed Rafailovitc that there was no December meeting for MAT; reported that there are slots available for the Homeless Outreach Training
- Consumer Advisory Group -Danny Osley reported that the report from the recent homeless symposium was distributed via the email group; Jo-Ann Anstett suggested that this report should be discussed at the February meeting after everyone has had a chance to read the report.
