- BBHC Update William King reported Village South has formally taken over the operations of the former Susan B. Anthony programming and reported that BBHC is working closely with Village South to ensure

smooth operations. He reported that some fellowship respite beds are now available for clients who are awaiting treatment beds to become available. Information will be distributed to the HPSC mailing list.

- PIT- provided earlier in the meeting.
- Housing Action Committee -TC reported that the Committee continues looking into developing a homelessness-specific landlord database in MLS format, in partnership with one of the local Realtors' Associations. Keith Cavanaugh reported that he continues leading an effort to develop a set of standards for clients and landlords, building on existing documents that have been published. TC reported that the Committee is planning a landlord appreciation event in July and that assistance will be needed from everyone on the planning and implementation of that event.
- Consumer Advocacy Committee Mark Eska reported that this group is merging with the Coffee and Conversation group hosted by the main library, but there has been no movement on this transition. Reported that he will work on getting the group to make some movement.
