The Department of Environmental Protection hereby provides Notice of Intent to issue a permit for the proposed project, subject to the conditions specified in the draft permit and summarized below. The applicant, City of Delray Beach, Hassan Hadjimiri, PE, Director of Utilities, 434 South Swinton Avenue, Delray Beach, Florida 33444 applied on October 25, 2022 for a permit to construct and operationally test a Class I Injection Well. The project is located at the Delray Beach Water Treatment Plant, 200

SW 6th Street, Delray Beach, Florida 33444, in Palm Beach County File No. 427899-001-UC/1X, WACS ID No. 107654).

The facility will construct and operationally test one, non-hazardous Class I injection well (IW-1) and associated dual-zone monitor well (DZMW-1) for the disposal of concentrate byproduct from nanofiltration and reverse osmosis membrane treatment of groundwater from the City of Delray Beach Water Treatment Plant. The maximum injection rate for IW 1 shall be 3,507 gallons per minute (gpm) and the maximum injection volume for IW-1 shall be 0.5 million gallons per day (mgd). The injection well will be constructed with a 20-inch diameter casing set to 2,520 feet below land surface (b/s), a nominal 13.375-inch diameter fiberglass-reinforced plastic tubing set to 2,520 feet below land surface (b/s), and a total depth of 3,200 feet b/s. The dual-zone monitor well, DZMW-1 will be completed in the Floridan aquifer from 1,620 to 1,670 feet b/s and from 1,850 to 1,900 feet b/s.

The Department has permitting jurisdiction under Chapter 403 of the Florida Statutes (F.S.) and the rules adopted thereunder. The project is not exempt from permitting procedures. The Department has determined that an Underground Injection Control permit is required for the proposed work.

The Department will issue the permit less a petition for an administrative hearing is timely filed under Sections 120.569 and 120.57, F.S., before the deadline for filing a petition. On the filing of a timely and sufficient petition, this action will not be final until after the next meeting of the Department. Because the administrative hearing process is designed to formulate final agency action, the hearing process may result in a modification of the agency action or even denial of the application.

Petition for Administrative Hearing
 A person whose substantial interests are affected by the Department's action (including petitioning for an administrative hearing) under Sections 120.569 and 120.57, F.S. A statement of the specific rules or statutes that the petitioner contends require reversal or modification of the agency's proposed action, including an explanation of how the alleged facts relate to the specific rules or statutes; and
 g. A statement of the relief sought by the petitioner, stating precisely the action that the petitioner wishes the agency to take with respect to the agency's proposed action.
