

1 A bill entitled

2 An act relating to the Coral Springs Improvement District,
3 Broward County, amending chapter 2004-469, Laws of Florida;
4 providing for conformance with procurement of personal property
5 and services as contained in Florida Statute 287; providing for
6 an effective date.

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8 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

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10 Section 1. Section 47 of Chapter 2004-469, laws of Florida
11 is amended to read:

13 Section 47. Bids required. -

14 (1) No contract shall be let by the board for any
15 goods, supplies, or materials to be purchased when the amount
16 thereof to be paid by the district shall exceed the amount
17 provided in section 287.017, Florida Statutes, for category
18 four, unless notice of bids shall be advertised once in a
19 newspaper in general circulation in the county and in the
20 district. The board, if seeking to construct or improve a
21 public building, structure, or other public works, shall comply
22 with the bidding procedures of section 255.20, Florida Statutes,
23 and other applicable general law. In each case, the bid of the
24 lowest responsive and responsible bidder shall be accepted
25 unless all bids are rejected because the bids are too high, or
26 the board determines it is in the best interests of the district
27 to reject all bids. The board may require the bidders to
28 furnish bonds with a responsible surety to be approved by the
29 board. Nothing in this section shall prevent the board from
30 undertaking and performing the construction, operation, and

31 maintenance of any project or facility authorized by this act by
32 the employment of labor, material, and machinery.

33 (2) The provisions of the Consultants' Competitive
34 Negotiation Act, section 287.055, Florida Statutes, apply to
35 contracts for engineering, architecture, landscape architecture,
36 or registered surveying and mapping services let by the board.

37 (3) Contracts for maintenance services for any
38 district facility or project shall be subject to competitive
39 bidding requirements when the amount thereof to be paid by the
40 district exceeds the amount provided in section 287.017, Florida
41 Statutes, for category four. The district shall adopt rules,
42 policies, or procedures establishing competitive bidding
43 procedures for maintenance services. Contracts for other
44 services shall not be subject to competitive bidding unless the
45 district adopts a rule, policy, or procedure applying
46 competitive bidding procedures to said contracts.

47 (4) The district may apply to the Department of
48 Management Services, or entity succeeding to the duties of such
49 department, to purchase commodities and contractual services
50 from purchasing agreements established and state term contracts
51 procured pursuant to section 287.057, Florida Statutes, by such
52 department, as provided in section 287.056, Florida Statutes.
53 ~~No contract shall be let by the board for the construction or~~
54 ~~maintenance of any project authorized by this act, nor shall any~~
55 ~~goods, supplies, or materials be purchased when the amount~~
56 ~~thereof to be paid by said district shall exceed \$4,000, unless~~
57 ~~notice of bids shall be advertised once a week for 2 consecutive~~
58 ~~weeks in a newspaper published in Broward County and of general~~
59 ~~circulation in the district, and in each case the bid of the~~
60 ~~lowest responsible bidder shall be accepted, unless all bids are~~
61 ~~rejected because the bids are too high. The board may require~~
