IMPORTANT REMINDER - TIPS FOR REPORTING ILLEGAL DUMPING!

Unlawful or improper dumping has negative impacts on communities that extends far beyond the eyesore that is left behind. Whenever it appears that illegal dumping is actively occurring, call the Broward Sheriff's non-emergency number at 954-764-4357 to report it. If you can safely get license plate information or note any distinguishing information such as business signs, this can be very helpful. Photos are even better, but it is not recommended that you interact with persons who are doing the dumping, this is a law enforcement matter. However, if the dumping has already occurred and there is no evidence of who was responsible, then it should be reported to BMSD Code Compliance for investigation by calling 311.



311 CALL CENTER



When you call 311, you'll reach someone who can connect you with the services and programs offered by the more than 60 agencies comprising Broward County government. Callers are provided a fast, simple and convenient way to speak with trained, professional information specialists. The Call Center handles calls in any language and has English, Spanish and Creole-speaking specialists on staff. Residents and businesses can easily report and track service requests to the County using the free MyBroward app, or by accessing the system online through [MyBroward.Broward.org](https://www.broward.org/MyBroward). Res-

idents can report potholes, malfunctioning traffic lights and smoking vehicles or request services like mosquito spraying, to name a few. As soon as the request is sent, the resident will be notified that the request has been received and they'll be able to track its progress.

The Call Center is open Monday through Friday, from 8:30AM to 5PM. For general inquiries and assistance, call 311 or 954-831-4000. The Homeless Helpline is open Monday through Friday, from 8AM to 6PM, and Saturday and Sunday from 8AM to Noon. Homeless Helpline operating hours on holidays are 8AM to Noon. For emergencies, call 911.

PUBLIC WORKS CONSTRUCTION PROJECTS



Boulevard Gardens' drainage system cleaning, inspection and small repairs: This project is the first phase of a larger project, and this work has been expedited to ensure the drainage system is cleared of debris and other materials due to the recent heavy rain events. The project is funded by the Transportation Surtax. The project started in August 2023, with completion expected in June 2024.

Franklin Park Sidewalk and Road improvements: Includes installation of new sidewalks, swales restoration, milling and resurfacing and the traffic separator. This project is the second phase

of a larger project. This project has been expedited to ensure timely completion improvements of the current conditions of the drainage system, sidewalks, and swales within the neighborhood. The project started August 2023, with anticipated completion in March 2024.
