Lonicera sempervirens	Coral Honeysuckle Vine	Hummingbirds, thrushes, orioles, mockingbirds, Catbirds, and other fruit-eating birds
Muhlenbergia capillaries	Muhly grass	Cover for small birds; seeds for cardinals, buntings, sparrows
Passiflora suberosa	Corky-stem Passion Flower Vine	Hummingbirds, fruit and insect-eating birds

Many species of birds are summer, winter, or migrant visitors. Marine species are migrants too - sea turtles nest on our beaches in the summer and manatees winter in our waterways.
