- The *Broward Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO)* is a federally-mandated agency that:
  - Makes policy on local transportation issues and
  - Decides how to spend federal money on transportation projects within Broward County.

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






### **TOTAL REVENUES (2045 MTP)**
