# BACKGROUND Municipal Capital Projects





#### Municipal Projects in 2018 Surtax Plan

Municipalities submitted projects for inclusion in the 2018 Original Plan approved by voters:

- totaling \$3.3B of the anticipated \$16.5B in surtax revenues over the 30-year program (for shuttles, capital, and rehab and maintenance projects)
- no cap or "maximum" amount per project or per municipality was imposed
- determining statutory eligibility of all proposed projects and proposed expenditures contained in the original 2018 plan, and any new projects, was always the purview of the Oversight Board per Surtax Ordinance and ILA
- muni projects included no specified years of delivery because ranking and prioritization was to be completed by the MPO after surtax became effective (per Surtax Ordinance, multi-party ILA, and Surtax Services ILA)





### Surtax Interlocal Agreements(ILA) Overview

- "Global" multi-party ILA became effective September 2018 between: Broward MPO; 29 Participating Municipalities; Broward County
  - The global Surtax ILA has been amended twice; the 2<sup>nd</sup> Amendment controls the new prioritization process presented earlier by the MPO
- MPO and County ILA controls the funding mechanism for the required project application process for <u>municipal capital projects (MCPs)</u> effective May 2019
- During Cycle 1, eligibility of MCPs was determined by Oversight Board after recommendations were presented to the County by MPO
- Under new process, eligibility of recommended MCPs will first be reviewed by Surtax General Counsel before being brought to the Oversight Board
- Broward County guarantees a minimum of 10% annual Surtax revenue for municipal projects and initiatives (capital, R&M, shuttles & contingency)



# Cycle 1 MPO Municipal Surtax Role





#### Cycle 1 MPO Recommended Projects

- Original plan contained 700+ municipal projects with construction cost estimates
- After Cycle 1 review and ranking process concluded (February 28, 2020), MPO recommended Municipal Capital Projects (MCP) in 3 phases:
  - Planning
  - Design
  - Construction
- Construction projects were recommended for funding based on their "Readiness" (complete design)
- Planning projects were recommended @ 3% of construction cost estimates (in most instances)
- Design projects were recommended @ 12% of construction cost estimate





## Cycle 1 MPO Recommended Projects

- The Municipal Capital Project overview was prepared by the MPO in collaboration with the participating municipalities and Broward County
- The MPO recommended 110 projects for Cycle 1 funding on February 28, 2020
  - Only municipal projects in the Original Plan were presented to the Oversight Board (required by interlocal agreements)





### Cycle 1 MPO Recommended Projects

- Detailed Overview Sheets with project descriptions, scopes, objectives, and costs were provided for all recommended projects
- Oversight Board Members reviewed the information provided for each project
- Municipalities had the opportunity to present their projects and provide clarifications to the Oversight Board during the May 22, 2020 and June 4, 2020 Board meetings
- The County Commission approved Cycle 1 municipal project recommendations June 16, 2020 <u>Agenda Item 20-1051</u>

#### Municipal Capital Projects (MCP) Conversion Requests

- 2<sup>nd</sup> Amendment to the Global ILA includes process for phase conversion requests
- The following Municipalities reached out to MAP Admin regarding municipal projects recommended & approved for design phase funding, that are no longer wanted or needed:
  - Lauderdale-By-The-Sea (LBTS)
  - Parkland
  - Pompano Beach
- Each municipality requesting conversion has been asked to present their request and answer any questions posed





#### MCP Phase Conversion Request - LBTS

- City of LBTS submitted a written request to County Commissioner and then MAP Admin in 2020 requesting conversion of Design award for El Mar Drive, which was funded with another source and solicitation had been let
- Since the original requests for conversion, public outreach has occurred, and the municipality is re-evaluating the scope of the original project
- Municipal representatives will speak to the project and status of the conversion request (see also Agenda Item 3A, Exhibit 1 for information)

### MCP Phase Conversion Request - Parkland

- City of Parkland submitted a written request to MAP Admin on 2/4/2021 for design-phase conversion requests for municipal capital projects PARK-002 & PARK-007
- Both PARK-002 & PARK-007 were recommended and approved for Cycle 1 Design funding
  - Design for PARK-002 has been fully funded by FDOT
  - Warrants required for PARK-007 Design are not ready

#### MCP Phase Conversion Request

- City of Pompano Beach submitted a written request to MAP Admin on 3/9/2021 for Design phase conversion requests for POMP-002
  - POMP-002 was approved for Cycle 1 Design funds
  - Design funds have been secured through GO Bonds & City wishes to transfer approved design surtax money to construction to expedite project
  - Construction phase is included in 5YP (FY23 & FY24)
