NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

In accordance with Section 163.3174, Florida Statutes, the Broward County Resilient Environment Department, Urban Planning Division will conduct a Local Planning Agency (LPA) public hearing on December 20, 2022, at 3:00pm in the 2nd Floor Hearing Room at 1 North University Drive, Plantation, FL, 33324. The purpose of the public hearing is to receive public comments and make a recommendation to the Board of County Commissioners on

the following items:

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA, PERTAINING TO FRONT YARD FENCES LOCATED IN ROOSEVELT GARDENS; AMENDING SECTION 39-638 OF THE BROWARD COUNTY CODE OF ORDINANCES ("CODE"); AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY, INCLUSION IN THE CODE, AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

At the public hearing, any person shall be entitled to be heard regarding the subject of the public hearing.

Please be advised that any person who decides to appeal any decision made by the LPA with respect to any matter considered at the public hearing will need a recording of the proceedings, and that for such purpose, will need to ensure that a verbatim record of the proceeding is made, which record includes the testimony and evidence upon which the appeal is to be based. This notice and advice that a record is required to appeal any decision is made pursuant to Section 286.0105, Florida Statutes. Publish December 7, 2022.
