2. BOARD ELECTIONS

Two new Human Rights Board appointees were welcomed to the Human Rights Board.

5. ADOPTION OF AGENDA

On Motion of Mr. Rajner, seconded by Ms. Feiler, and unanimously carried, the Human Rights Board adopted the Agenda, as submitted.

6. <u>APPROVAL OF BOARD MEETING MINUTES</u>

On Mr. Rajner's Motion approve minutes, as amended, to reflect the names corrections for Ms. Feiler and Dr. Davis-Jerome, seconded by Ms. Estevez.

7. CHAIR'S REPORT

8. LITIGATION REPORT

Mr. Katzman provided an update on four cases litigated by the County Attorney's Office. In these cases, the Section found Reasonable Cause to believe Respondent violated the Fair Housing Act and/or the Broward County Human Right Act.

In Richmond v. Thor Guard, alleging sex and pregnancy employment discrimination, the parties resolved the matter for \$15,000. In Gokool v. A Brand-New Start d/b/a Hunter's Nightclub, alleging disability discrimination in public accommodation, the case is pending dates for hearing.

In the Cintron v. Environ Towers, Inc. and Ferebee v. Wilton Station Condominium Association, Inc. et al., alleging housing discrimination on the bases of disability, both parties made elections to have their cases heard in federal court.

9. ANNOUNCEMENTS/CONCERNS/REQUEST FOR FUTURE AGENDA ITEMS/PUBLIC COMMENT

Dr. Davis-Jerome provided that the United Nations Association recently celebrated the 70th Anniversary Human Rights Day and that all went well. Dr. Davis-Jerome requested a status update of CEDAW.

Ms. Estevez also expressed some concerns related to the hearing panel and timing.

Mr. Katzman swore in the New Chair and Vice-Chair.

10. ADJOURNMENT

With no further business to come before the Board, the meeting was adjourned at 4:23 PM.
